## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

“Do not be afraid” — fear not — is a recurring theme in the Scriptures. The fears that invade our lives are many. Is it loss of a job, loss of health, loss of memory? Is it terrorist threats or the stock market? Do we fear loss of faith or changing technology that seems to leave us scrambling just to keep up? For teenagers it may be fear of not being popular, of not fitting in.

St. Augustine had good advice in the face of these nagging fears. He said: “Leave the past to the mercy of God; leave the present to the love of God and the future to the providence of God.”

Pope John XXIII displayed a faithful spirit as he retired each night to sleep. “It’s your church, Lord, the Pope is going to sleep.”

Fr. Michael Tugwell, the Australian writer, tells us: “Christianity is not just a sophisticated program of self-improvement. It is eternal life that is at stake. And it is for this that our timidly clutching fingers must be pried open.” As Teresa of Avila reminded us we are too timid in prayer, asking for too little and not enough.

Today’s Scripture reading invites us to move from fear to faith. Faith, we are told in the reading from Hebrews (Ch. 11, 1-19) involves trust in God’s promises — things hoped for and not yet seen. Faith is described to us as “confident assurance” concerning what we hope for and conviction about things we do not see.

In reply to the little boy who asked his father why it is we don’t build great cathedrals anymore like the great marvels in Europe (Notre Dame, Chartres), the father said, “To build cathedrals, my son, you need conviction and nowadays we have opinions but not conviction.”

What we hope for in the end is life, life with God. Our hope is to see God, face to face. Hope is not optimism. It is based on God’s promises.

We live in watchfulness and waiting. When we forget this and act irresponsibly in dominating others or in being reckless, we miss the goal of life.

**Off To College:** Many of our students will be heading back to college shortly. Some for the first time and others returning for another year. Who can doubt the challenges that college life presents today? Thus, faith is tested and pushed to the limit. Religious faith and religious practice may be questioned by some students as quaint or old-fashioned. With God’s grace and a little bit of luck, our students from Our Lady of the Lake will come through with an even stronger faith and will be faithful witnesses.

*The "Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program" began in 1960 as a project of the Columbian Squires of North America to honor the Blessed Virgin under her title of "Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas". The program has continued since then as a project of Squires Circles, Councils and 4th Degree Assemblies. In 2001 Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson expanded the program by beginning the "Running of the Silver Rose" from the 119th Annual meeting of the Supreme Council in Ontario, Canada to Monterrey, Mexico, through the United States. "The 'Running of the Silver Rose' is a perfect program for the Knights of Columbus," said Supreme Knight Anderson. "Through it we honor not only Our Lady of Guadalupe and express the Unity of the Order, but we also reaffirm the Order's dedication to the sanctity of human life. It is to the Blessed Mother that we turn in prayer as we work to end the Culture of Death that grips our society. As we think in terms of 'One Life, One Rose,' it is most appropriate we turn to Our Lady of Guadalupe who made known her will through Juan Diego and the miracle of the roses." 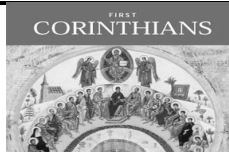

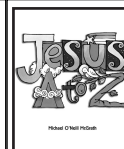
