## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

The tax collector in today's Gospel parable got it right. He said in prayer: "O God be merciful to me a sinner".

We begin every celebration of the Eucharist with the stark reminder of our sins. "I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do". Look around our world: there's a lot of evidence of human sinfulness.

Each of us knows that sometimes it's my fault; sometimes it's our fault; and sometimes it's not our fault but we are all in this together. We all bear the consequences of each other's sins, whether the "other" is perpetrating ethnic cleansing in Syria, or abusing a child or a spouse in the house across the street, or tweeting the latest gossip, or looking the other way instead of recognizing the face of Christ in the one who is "different".

The Pharisee, in his prayer, said: "God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity". The problem with this attitude is that I am like them. I might wish I weren't but, the truth is, we're all sinners.

The bigger truth of course is: God in Christ has offered mercy to all of us. That's worth celebrating. In the recent extensive interview that Pope Francis gave to the Italian Jesuit Journal (and which was later published in other major Jesuit journals around the world) he made headlines when he was asked: "Who is Jorge Mario Bergoglio?" He replied: "I am a sinner." this is the most accurate definition. It is not a figure of speech, a literary genre. "I am a sinner". He hastened to add, however: "I am a sinner whom the Lord has looked upon." That's what makes the difference. Pope John Paul II once said: "Do not be afraid of your sins." We must acknowledge them!

### Annual Thanksgiving Food Drive

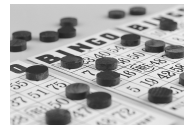

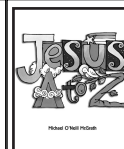
