PASTOR'S MESSAGE

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of Christmas time and the beginning of ordinary time.

The Baptism of Jesus is mentioned in all four Gospels. In the revised Liturgical Calendar of the Church it is a special feast day always celebrated on a Sunday to emphasize its importance in the life of the Church. In the Gospel it marks the inauguration of the public ministry of Jesus.

The Reading from Isaiah (42:1-4, 6-7) is part of a long meditation on the servant of the Lord. He will come quietly and gently—so gently that even the frail reed that is already bent will not be broken, and the wick that is already smoldering will not be put out. And yet this quiet, humble servant, who is Jesus, will establish a new kingdom, a realm of justice.

We meet so many whose lives are bent. Bent out of shape by hardships and set backs, by tragedies and disappointments. Will we find a comforting word for them, a healing gesture to lift them up? And we meet so many who are grasping for faith, holding on to some shred of hope, like smoldering wicks. Will we re-ignite their frayed faith and fragile hope by a kind word and a listening heart? It is so easy to break the “bruised” reed or extinguish the smoldering wick by thoughtless words or words that condemn.

Matthew's account of the Baptism differs from the other Gospel accounts in several ways. John stops Jesus as he comes to him at the Jordan—"I need to be Baptized by you, and yet you are coming to me?" (Mt 3:14). This reflects the difficulties the early Christians had with Jesus' undergoing John's Baptism of repentance. Since Jesus was sinless from birth why would he need to go through this ritual?

The response of Jesus is enigmatic or mysterious. "Let it be", he says to John, "for it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness". Righteousness denotes good order or right relationship with God, self, others, and all creation. Jesus came to bring such right relationships.

After Jesus' Baptism, something marvelous happens as the heavens are opened, and God's voice is heard as it was on the day of creation. The words of God that echo over the waters of the Jordan are addressed to all:—"This is my beloved son, with whom I am well pleased". In dramatic fashion Matthew reminds us that Jesus is Son of God and Son of David.


