## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

We have begun the journey together on Ash Wednesday, the journey that will take us to the great day of Easter and will culminate in the renewal of our Baptismal promises and the reception of new members into our Church. In a sense, this is the Church's annual retreat, taking time to ponder the things that matter.

I have great hopes for this community of Our Lady of the Lake as we set out in this Lenten journey. There is so much goodness and goodwill and faith that seeks to be strong; a willingness to attend anew to the reading of sacred scripture and to pursue the path of conversion through prayer and fasting. With God's grace great things can happen this Lent. My hope is that we will all come to Easter with minds and hearts renewed. The hope too is that the poor will impact us in this Lenten time as we find ways to share with those in need.

Pope Francis has a special focus on Lent that he would like all of us to embrace. He focuses on the poverty of Christ in becoming man, emphasizing that it is our duty to give the same humble witness in our care for the poor.

The Pope has adopted a verse of scripture (2 Corinthians 8:9): "For you know the gracious act of our Lord Jesus Christ, that for your sake he became poor although he was rich, so that by his poverty you might become rich." He writes: "Upon seeing poverty around us, in imitation of our Master, we Christians are called to confront the poverty of our brothers and sisters, to touch it, to make it our own and to take practical steps to alleviate it."

Pope Francis encourages us "to imitate Christ who became poor and enriched us by his poverty". He reminds us that Lent is a fitting time for self-denial, and we would do well to ask ourselves what we can give up in order to help and enrich others by our own poverty. Much food for thought here!

### **Bishop Raymond Boland: In Memoriam.**

Bishop Boland, the second Bishop to serve our Diocese (1988-1993), following the death of Bishop Joseph Vath, died last week in Ireland after a long battle with cancer. I had the privilege of serving as his Vicar General and came to know him as a faithful and dedicated priest and Bishop. A humble servant of the Gospel, he fulfilled well St. Paul's description "as a servant of Christ and a steward of the mysteries of God". He was a tireless worker in the Lord's vineyard and cared little for his own self-aggrandizement or convenience. May he rest in peace and rise in glory.

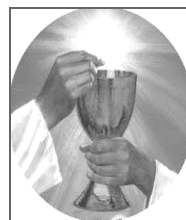

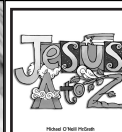
