

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

In St. Paul's Cathedral in London lies buried an Anglican priest, Samuel Barnet, who worked faithfully for many years in east London slums. On his memorial stone is carved the figure of the sower of Jesus' parable, walking down the field, scattering seed freely. Underneath are these words: "Fear not to sow on account of the birds".

Remembering the confidence expressed in today's Gospel parable, we too may sow with confidence. Sowing seeds of goodness and spreading the Good News of the Gospel along the road of life will bring unexpected results. The harvest will surprise us.

In the reading from Isaiah (55:10-11) and in the Gospel reading this Sunday (Matthew 13:1-23) our attention is directed to the world of nature as a means of understanding the Word of God and how God's Word takes root in our lives and in our world.

Farmers who are close to the earth and have observed the laws of nature at work in the field and farm know two things. The first thing that is striking is the losses and failures that occur in sowing and planting. A lot of potential is frustrated by quirks of nature like floods and storms and disease. The second thing that is even more striking is the bounty, the extravagance of nature that yields abundant harvests and overflowing fruitfulness. Think of the few tomato plants you planted in your garden. They seem to go on giving and growing in ways that surprise you.

In the reading from Isaiah, God's Word is likened to the rain and the snow that drench the earth, purifying it and making it fruitful. So is God's Word that falls upon our lives and transforms us again and again.

The Gospel parable points to the farmer planting seed in the spring. There seems to be a lot of failure, seed that doesn't take root for many reasons. But then there is the harvest at the end yielding astonishing results. This harvest of 30-100 percent is beyond all imagining. Here is cause for joy and hope. "Fear not to sow on account of birds".



SUMMER CHALLENGE taken from the "Joy of the Gospel Study Guide" by Bill

Huebsch: **Invitation to all** to pause at this moment in their lives and allow their hearts to be touched by Christ. Be renewed! Do this daily. This is for EVERYONE. If you take risk of giving yourself, heart and soul, to Christ, he will respond each and every time. His arms are open. Don't ever stop returning to Christ with your whole heart.

REFLECTION : Temptations are faced by all who work in and for the church.. We all fall short, but every effort made for our society is a stepping stone to a better world. We try to help people live and die in peace. We try to help them escape poverty and enslavement. We devote ourselves to education and outreach. Don't look at your ministry as just another job. Don't prize relaxation or personal freedom too much. Don't reduce faith to a few religious exercises but keep it disconnected from the world. Our culture is often cynical about our beliefs and this sadly can lead to a loss of enthusiasm. Remember to have JOY we must live JOY—Jesus first; Others second and You last. We have forgotten how to die to self; it is out of fashion. We want immediate results and we lack the patience to wait on the Lord for the completed project. Our church must not become a museum—dry, dead and lifeless. We must rely on the Holy Spirit to get up and get going. We will not be defeated. We have grace and that is always enough. We have grace and grace empowers us to succeed in doing what God wants. Let us not be robbed of community!

QUESTION: How and when have you experienced the Church becoming dry and lifeless rather than on fire with the love of Jesus Christ? Are there too many cliques? Are we at odds with other Christians in the community? Are we in danger of being too worldly? Are we judgmental or uncharitable? Pope Francis has invited us to talk about and find solutions in our churches and in our communities. If you have a plan or desire don't hesitate to share it. We must reach out and share the faith. Don't let the world consume you!



