

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"Our Gospel did not come to you in word alone, but also in power". Thus Paul writes to the Thessalonians (I Thess. 1:15) in our second reading for this Sunday. If it's only words, we might as well save our ink. The world does not lack for words. Indeed we are drowning in useless, empty words every day. But the Scriptures that we hold so dear are more than mere words. They point to something real. They speak about the Word uttered by God before all time and made flesh in time—Christ, who brings forgiveness.

That's the Good News: the Word has reunited us with God despite sin and death. The words of Sacred Scripture carry immeasurable power. We do well to live by these words and to make them our rule of life.

King Cyrus of Persia (600-529 B.C.) was an extraordinary figure in history. The people of Israel were conquered by Babylon in approximately 586 B.C. Many of the rich, powerful, and educated of the Israelites were taken away. This is referred to as the Babylonian Captivity.

When Cyrus conquered Babylon, he chose to do something amazing. He sent the Israelites home. Not only did he release them, he sent them with materials and even workers to rebuild the Temple, which had been destroyed. Cyrus is mentioned favorably twenty-two times in the Old Testament.

Our Scripture passage today from the Old Testament (Isaiah 45:1,4-6) praises Cyrus as an instrument of God. Even though Cyrus did not recognize the Lord as his God, the Lord still is God of Cyrus, the Persian. God works through all and in all in writing the script of history.

The Gospel reading today (Mt. 22:15-21) reminds us that the conflict between Church and State is not new. There are legitimate loyalties that belong to God (our worship and the moral law) and those that belong to the State (the taxes we pay, the civil laws we follow).

Jesus utters those famous words: "Give to Caesar what is Caesars, but give to God what is God's". Is he endorsing the principle of separation of Church and State? Not exactly. All creation, all power ultimately comes from God, as Isaiah reminds us in the first reading.

The Church Father (writer) Tertullian said, "You must give to Caesar what bears the image of Caesar, and to God what bears the image of God: that is yourself". We belong to God always even if we are citizens of a State. When there is a conflict of conscience, St. Peter said it well: "We must obey God rather than man".

A Lovely Prayer: Used in the Homily on October 12 and requested by some of you in print form: "O God, nothing is so real as you! Nothing so alive. The galaxies do not stretch the width of your thumbs. What are we that you even bother to make us? Still, by your grace, every movement of our spirits toward the light, every turning from evil and ugliness, every persistence in hungering for selfless love, brings us out of ourselves and toward your limitless mystery. Never let us be parted from you". (Fr. Joseph Nolen).




