## Pastor's Message

TRANSFIGURATION. This Sunday in Lent, the Scripture speaks of transfiguration or transformation, a theophany in which the glory of Jesus is revealed to Peter, James and John. The word “transfigured” is more than a change in appearance. It is more profound. It implies a changed state of being.

Mark notes (9:2-10) that this took place “six days” after Peter’s confession of Jesus as the Messiah. Was Mark thinking of the six days of creation in Genesis before God’s Sabbath rest? It foreshadows a new creation, an image of what God’s final kingdom will be like. We will all “be changed and utterly changed” in the words of the Irish poet, W.B. Yeats.

Jesus took the three disciples “up a high mountain apart by themselves”. Mark tells us they too were changed for a brief moment. This is a glimpse, an intimation of what is to come.

It is significant that Jesus is pictured conversing with the two greatest figures of Jewish tradition, Moses and Elijah, representatives of the Law and the Prophets. It is a timeless moment. Jesus is in a continuity with the figures of Jewish wisdom. Not only in continuity however, for this Jesus is “God’s beloved Son”.

Peter, James and John were also privileged to witness the raising to life of the little girl (Mark 5:37); they will also accompany Jesus into the Garden of Gethsemane (14:33). Peter’s desire to build three tents on the mountain indicates a keen insight. In Jewish life there was an annual Feast of Tabernacles in which tents were constructed at the harvest time to foreshadow the end time of God’s final kingdom.

Peter was right in saying: “Lord, it is good that we are here”. It was a moment of awe and wonder. He is overwhelmed by the goodness of God’s presence. It is a transfiguration moment, though ever so brief.

The vision of future glory fades abruptly. Soon the disciples were coming down from the mountain. Their descent is not only physical but spiritual. They return from a brief moment of insight and glory to their everyday lives of dulled understanding. The struggle to believe would continue.

What have been my transfiguration moments in life? How have they helped me to go on with life in the daily grind? Lent reminds us of our true calling- - to be transformed, to share the glory of God. Oh, how good it is to be here!



Beginning with the first Sunday of Lent, Feb

22nd and at the 8:30am Mass only, we will be asking our children from Kindergarten thru Grade 3 to join us at a Children's Liturgy of the Word.
