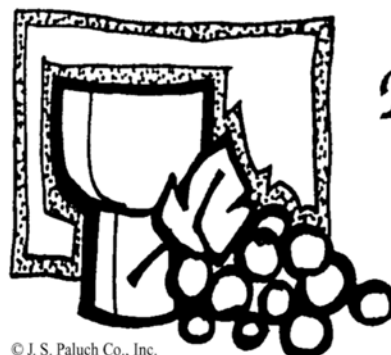

Pastor's Message

Feast of Corpus Christi (The Body of Christ). This lovely feast of the Eucharist is at the heart of our faith. Here we meet the God who feeds us and nourishes us in our pilgrim way through life.

The Eucharist is the great Sacrament of presence and nurture. It is the presence - the real presence - of Jesus among us, under the signs of bread and wine. He promised to be with us always until the end of the ages.

Here in the Eucharist, this promised presence is most powerfully fulfilled. He is present to us too in the Word proclaimed in the Liturgy; present in the faithful congregation that gathers in the Church each week; present in the priest who presides at the Eucharist; present too in the poor and needy.

In the Eucharist Jesus is present for us that we might unite with Him in giving worship to the Father and that we might receive Him in Holy Communion. Here is our spiritual food and nourishment. Here we are nourished each week for the continuing journey of life. Without this food and nourishment we grow tired along the way.

Our great hope and prayer is that we will receive Holy Communion for the last time before we close our eyes in death. It is the final or last Sacrament offered at the end and then called "Viaticum"- food for the final journey. I bet you thought anointing of the sick was the final Sacrament. A common misunderstanding by many of us.

The Gospel Reading from Mark (14:12-26) highlights the narrative of the institution of the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper. Mark, as always, uses an economy of words: "While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, saying: take it; this is my Body.... Then He took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, This is my Blood of the Covenant which will be shed for many."

A man carrying a jar of water would provide a special room in which to celebrate the Passover- Eucharist. The man is every man (and every woman) summoned from the dailiness of life and invited to share hospitality with the Risen Lord. The result can be astounding.

Commissioning of Special Ministers of Holy Communion. At the Masses this weekend we are commissioning for another year those who have volunteered and been trained to serve as Special Ministers at Mass and in bringing Holy Communion to the sick. "A Ministry of immense love", said Pope Paul VI. A special thanks to all of you.

Eucharistic Procession: Following the 8:30 Mass today we will have a special procession through the Church grounds in honor of the Holy Eucharist, while singing hymns along the way. The Canopy used in the procession was made by a devoted parishioner, Sarah Reese- Thanks for a work of beauty. We are grateful also for the Knights of Columbus for their part in the procession. This is the sixth year in which we have held the procession as a public way of honoring the Eucharist. The recommendation came to us from David Wesson, then a tenth grade student. He is now a senior at St. John's University in

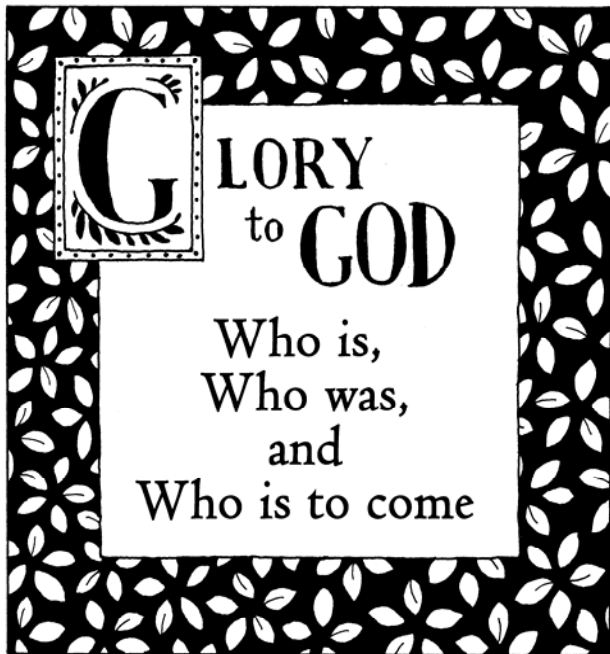

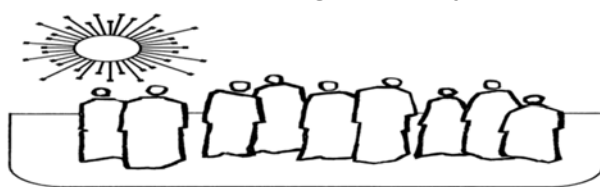

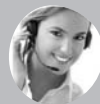
