## Pastor's Message

He woke up, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Quiet, be still". From today's Gospel Reading. Nature is amazing. Before it we are small. It has its own grandeur. We shudder before the power of nature.

The power of the sea is recognized even by those who live far from shifting tides. We hear how peoples crossed the sea in small boats, many dying on the way. Today, thousands and thousands fleeing persecution and hunger take to the seas again; rickety boats seeking refuge and a fresh start. Many are lost at sea. They surely must have cried out for help.

Storms seem to be a backdrop in today's Scriptures. Job in the midst of his personal storm where he lost everything had questioned—even challenged—God for an explanation. The result is that God speaks to Job in the longest speech in the Bible.

God after all, is not answerable to us and so he never gives Job an explanation. Can the creature question the Creator? God invites Job to consider the wonder of creation and the sheer power of nature. Job does not receive an answer to his question. He receives a glimpse into the mystery of God.

Storms can come in many forms, including discontent, despair, depression, doubt, a sudden illness, a loss of job, death in the family, break-up of a relationship. These are the personal storms that break over our lives — often uninvited, unexpected, and always bringing fear and anxiety.

At times like these we may feel abandoned, especially by God. The God who does not seem to hear our pleas for help. The silence of God is a challenge to us then. The great Japanese novelist, Shusaku Endo, titled his famous novel: Silence. We speak to the God who does not speak, even to our prayers, our cries for help. Or, so it seems.

That's how it seemed to the Disciples in the Gospel story today. "Jesus was in the boat, asleep on the cushion and they woke him up and said to him: "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?" They are not alone but they act as though they are. And that is what we forget. We are not alone.

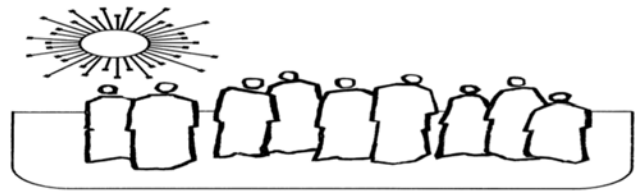

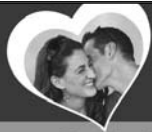
