Pastor's Message

Jealousy and unhealthy competition finds its way even into Church life. Turf wars are not limited to the world of business and education.

We have a natural tendency to think in terms of us and them. We're right, of course, and they—well we're not sure.

We must help not hinder each other and even join forces with anyone doing God's work. And that includes those who do not know the name of God or say it in prayer. They are still our allies if they are doing good work. It was Jesus who said: "one alone is good and that is God". Good people are God's workers in the vineyard.

- ◆ Whoever struggles for peace and justice.
- ◆ Whoever rescues the weak and the fallen.
- ◆ Whoever feeds the hungry and teaches the illiterate.
- ◆ Whoever defends and protects human life from conception to the grave.
- ◆ Whoever works with the sick and the lonely.
- ◆ Whoever speaks a word of hope and comfort.
- ◆ Whoever engages in the struggle against evil.

The Scripture readings this Sunday invite us to join forces and to be supportive of all who do good. Joshua was critical of Medad and Eldad. He said they were not approved (licensed, commissioned) to minister to the community and yet, the Spirit had come to them too. The response of Moses was generous. Let them be, he said; "Would that all the people were prophets".

St. Thomas Aquinas, repeating St. Ambrose said: "All truth, no matter by whom it is uttered, comes from the Holy Spirit. Humanity's groping quest for God is guided by God's quest for humanity". Wherever one is living out an authentic human existence, that existence is in touch with the many realities we speak of in Christian terms as Grace, Salvation and Faith.

Is this not part of the goodness of Pope Francis which is touching our country this week? "He is a man of dialogue, committed to the culture of encounter, who looks for the best in people and is not judgmental. - - - He is a peacemaker who is ever listening to what the Spirit is saying to the Church. - - - He comes as a pastor, a humble pastor who never puts himself above anybody. - - - He sees each one as a child of God, first and foremost, loved by Jesus, a brother or sister whom he loves too". (Gerald O'Connell, Vatican and Journalist).

I hope you will re-commit to whatever ministry you are involved in now, and, if you are looking for a ministry, that you will sign up this weekend. 
LOVE IS OUR MISSION




