## *Today's Readings*

## Pastor's Message

Seven brothers appear both in the First Reading (2 Maccabees 7:1-2; 9-14) and in the Gospel (Luke 20:27-38). The number seven has a special place in Biblical Literature. It is the perfect number symbolizing wholeness or completion. Genesis speaks of the seven days of creation, which included the seventh day as the Sabbath, the day of rest.

In the passage from 2 Maccabees, the ruthless king Antiochus attempts to coerce the brothers and their mother into eating pork. But it is more than a matter of pork. In reality they are being asked to deny their belief in God.

One by one, the brothers (and their mother) remain faithful to God's Law and refuse to eat pork. They are confident that God will raise them up to new life. The second brother stated: "The King of the world (God) will raise us up to live again forever".

The fourth brother, after he had been tortured and maltreated and when he was near death said: "It is my choice to die at the hands of men with the hope God gives of being raised up by Him; but for you (the king) there will be no resurrection".

This is what the Church calls martyrdom or dying for the Faith. This is what Christians in many countries today are doing in the face of cruel massacres and suffering. It is said that the blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church.

The other seven brothers appear in the Gospel today in the Sadducees' question about the Resurrection. It was an effort to manipulate Jesus and ridicule faith in the after life.

Jesus' response instructs the Sadducees and us that the question of sharing in the life of resurrection has nothing to do with our marital or societal status in the world or at death. God in Jesus Christ, for us, is the God of the Resurrection. In Him, we seek to share eternal life.


