Today's Readings

Gospel — Offer no resistance; love your enemies. (Matthew 5:38-48)

Pastor's Message

It is well to remember when we hear the teachings of Jesus in the Sermon on the Mount as we have in today's Gospel (Mt. 5:38-48) that this is a way of being holy as God is holy. To be holy was the special vocation of Israel: "Be holy, for I, the Lord, your God am holy".

Here Jesus proposes an ideal. A higher way is placed before us. All this presumes a graced existence. Not on our own power but when transformed by grace can we live such high ethical demands. "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be children of your heavenly father". Who can do this except with the help of God's grace?

These are strong Scriptures that are served up to us today. They are not for the faint of heart. They are a challenge to prevailing norms where force and retaliation rules. To follow the Sermon on the Mount is to be counter-cultural. We are called to heroic goodness not mediocrity.

In October, 2006, in the Amish community of Nickel Mines, Pennsylvania, five school children were killed by a crazed gunman who walked into their school in the middle of the day. The five girls were shot at random as they attended class.

The gunman was later arrested on the school grounds. The community was in shock that such a crime had happened in a peace-loving Amish community where people practice non-violence and value peace.

There was even more surprise a few days later when the leaders of the Amish community announced that the community had forgiven the murderer and set up a fund for his wife's support and that of her children. They invited the wife of the murderer to come to the children's funeral as a special guest.

Suddenly, a story about wanton violence and evil became a national story about forgiveness and reconciliation. The world needs stories such as this to reclaim what is best and most noble in the human spirit.


