

Pastor's Message

We have entered the great season of Lent with its powerful appeal. It is like an annual retreat for the Church. A time for the deepest questions about who we are and where we are going. In some ways it is a "Back to Basics" kind of time.

The current understanding of Lent is well expressed in a Ritual Book called The Ceremonial of Bishops. This is how Lent is described: "The Lenten season has a double character, namely, to prepare both catechumens and faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery. The catechumens (those preparing for baptism at Easter) both with the Rite of Election and scrutinies, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the Sacraments of Christian initiation; the faithful, ever more attentive to the Word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises".

The R.C.I.A. group of men and women who have been journeying with our Church since September become a special sign to us of the meaning of Lent. They are now in the final phase of their preparation for Easter Sacraments and we are asked to accompany them with our prayers and support. All of us will celebrate together, as a renewed community, when we renew our baptismal promises at the Easter Liturgy.

At the 11:15 Mass today the members of our R.C.I.A. group (some preparing for baptism, and some already baptized and seeking to be received into full communion with our Church) will be presented to the congregation as they sign their names in a special book to signify their serious intentions. As a congregation of Our Lady of the Lake Church we will then "send" the group to St. Paul's Cathedral in Birmingham to be welcomed by Bishop Baker and enrolled formally as Candidates for Easter Sacraments.

We have a special obligation to pray for our R.C.I.A. members as they enter this final phase. A word of welcome when we meet them in church or in the grocery store would also be an encouragement. It is all about reaching out and welcoming others.

Do you know of families or individuals who have become inactive in the Church? We all do. The season of Lent would be a great time to extend an invitation, a word of welcome to come home for Easter.

Prayer For the Week: "Let us open our eyes to the light that comes from God, and our ears to the voice from heaven that every day calls out this charge: If you hear his voice today, do not harden your hearts". (Psalm 95:8) Rule of St. Benedict.



Lenten Regulations

The annual observance of Lent is the special season for the ascent to the holy mountain of Easter. Through its twofold theme of repentance and baptism, the season of Lent disposes both the catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery. Catechumens are led to the Sacraments of Initiation by means of the Rite of Election, the scrutinies, and Catechesis. The faithful, listening more intently to the word of God and devoting themselves to prayer, are prepared through a spirit of repentance to renew their baptismal promises.

The Catholic Church, in an attempt to help Catholics do at least a minimum during Lent, asks all Catholics to fast and abstain from meat on certain days. **Fasting means** to limit food to one full meal a day with the possibility of two smaller meals (not adding up to a full meal) as needed. **Abstinence means** not eating meat, although fish is allowed. Catholics are asked to observe all days of fasting and abstinence which is one of the precepts of the Church.

Catholics 14 years of age or older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.


Catholics between the ages of 14 and 59 are also to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. If one's work or health make it inadvisable to fast or abstain from meat, they are not obligated to do so.






