Religious Education Code of Conduct

- 1. Class hours are 9:45 am 11am BE PROMPT! Masses are 8:30am & 11:15am
- 2. We have so little time to teach our children, please have your child in their class on time and ready to learn. Please be sure your younger children make a trip to the restroom <u>before</u> class.

Student Conduct

- 3. Students must use good Christian manners at all times.
- 4. Students may have homework assigned by the teacher, please ask your child if they have any and return the work the following week. This would be a good time for you to take part in the growth of your child's faith.
- 5. Any student not following directions or otherwise behaving in a disruptive manner will be taken out of the class and taken to the DRE.
- 6. There will be absolutely no physical or verbal abusive conduct. Any student who is abusive will be taken immediately to the DRE. The student may not return to class until the parents have been notified and the situation resolved.

Student Pick-up

- 7. Parents of children in <u>Pre-K through First Grade</u> must <u>pick up your children at the classroom door.</u> All other students will be dismissed through the Parish Hall.
 - All parents must pick up their child after Religious Education. No child will be allowed to leave the hall without a parent.
- 8. No child should be left unattended in the parking lot. Loitering in the parking lot is an accident waiting to happen. Please help us keep our children safe.

MORE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION and FEES: It is a pre-requisite of the dioceses that all students are registered prior to participating in the Religious Education Program. This supplies us with the important information we may need regarding the health, safety and emergency precautions for our students. An annual fee of \$15 per student, not to exceed \$45 per family is requested. This helps supply children with books, material and supplies needed. *No student is ever denied Religious Education because of fees.*

LITURGY: It is expected that all students AND parent attend Mass every weekend. Class time does not take the place of being present at Mass.

ATTENDANCE: Regular weekly attendance in class is expected by all students. Make this a priority! If a student misses three consecutive times communication with parent/guardian will follow. We want to make sure RE is a good experience for all!

YOUTH MASS: Every first Sunday of the month at the 11:15 a.m. Mass. Encourage your children to take an active part in the Liturgy as ushers, greeters, gift bearers, cantors and lectors.

YOUTH SAFETY: Child abuse is a serious concern. In accordance with the diocesan policy and legal codes, the parish staff, volunteers and catechists has a moral and legal duty to comply with the law to ensure the welfare of a child. All Staff members and volunteers who will be working with our youth in any capacity are required to complete a diocesan application form with a background check. A Youth Protection Class must be attended by all.

OFF PREMISIS ACTIVITIES: When activities are scheduled, diocesan guidelines concerning legal and safety issues will be followed. Parents will be provided with all required information in advance of a scheduled event, such as retreats, service projects or youth outings.
