#### Father Bill's Weekly Message

#### STEWARDS OF THE CHURCH

In Stewardship, A Disciple's Response, from the Catholic Bishops of the United States (1992), we read, "Because its individual members do collectively make up the Body of Christ, that body's health and well-being are the responsibility of the members- the personal responsibility of each one of us. We are all stewards of the Church."

Each of us has been given talents, gifts, from God. Human capabilities, relationships with family and friends, material goods, the work we do, and the world itself. The Gospels tell us that one day God will require an accounting of the use we have made of the opportunities He gave us. (See Matthew 25, 14-30)

We will never be perfect in our use of God's gifts. The issue is, did we use the talents and opportunities given us by God to serve God, who is the owner of those talents? What use did we make of God's gifts? The past cannot be changed, but it can be learned from.

"But how is the Church built up? In a sense there are as many answers to that question as there are individual members with individual vocations. But the overarching answer for all is this: through personal participation in and support of the Church's mission of proclaiming and teaching, serving and sanctifying." (Stewardship, p. 31)

This weekend our parish will have a Stewardship Fair in the parish hall following each Mass. Come by and see how your fellow parishioners are living out their faith. Perhaps there is a niche for you. Christianity is a way of life. Contemplation on the presence of Christ in the world is important. Christians are called to contemplative action. We are called to serve Jesus Christ. We are called to be the instruments He uses to continue His mission to draw all people to God. We are called to be Christian Stewards.


