Father Bill's Weekly Message

THE SCAPEGOAT

In the Old Testament, on the Day of Atonement, sin offerings were made by the Chief Priest for himself, his family, and for all the Israelites. He sacrificed a young bull and a male goat to the Lord. (Leviticus, 16)

Then he led another male goat outside the meeting tent and placed his hands on the head of the goat and confessed all the sins of the Israelite people. This goat was led outside the camp and taken into the wilderness, where it was supposed to take away the people's sins. Everyone who touched the goat had to purify themselves afterwards. Since the goat escaped being sacrificed to the Lord, it was called "the scapegoat."

We modern people are always looking for scapegoats. We like to blame others for our problems. Our sins always seem to be someone else's fault. We are adept at recognizing other people's responsibility, but not our own. If you follow political campaigns, it is always "the other side" who is responsible for everything wrong in our society.

Jesus was a scapegoat. He died for our sins. He took all our sins on His head and removed them from our midst. But, unlike the scapegoat, He rose from the dead and lives to take away our sins. In every Mass we pray, "Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world, have mercy on us." Jesus takes the place of the scapegoat in removing our sins.

But Jesus was also sacrificed for our sins. Like the other male goat, He died to make atonement. He lives to unite us to the Father. He is the mediator between God and us.

If other people are responsible for our sins, we do not need to be forgiven. They do. Jesus Christ's mercy is of no use to us unless we have sinned. Jesus Christ can only be our savior if we need to be saved.


