#### Father Bill's Weekly Message

#### WEDNESDAY MORNING MASS

This Wednesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, will be the final morning Mass at Ascension/St. Vincent Hospital chapel. In the official announcement from Ascension Healthcare, the following was included:

"Our hearts are filled with gratitude- first of all, to the Lord Jesus, for his sacramental Real Presence here in our midst for so many years; to the many priests who have offered Mass and visited our patients; to the many other patients, family members, and other faithful and visitors who have come here to pray and/or receive the sacraments."

The question of what to do about
Wednesday morning Mass remains. There were
parishioners and residents at the nearby Veterans'
Home that attended Mass regularly on Wednesday
mornings. I will be discussing the matter with
Monsignor Sexton, who regularly offered Mass
there, the deacons, the Pastoral Council, and the
Liturgy Committee about what we might do in the
future. Whatever is decided, two factors are to be
considered:

First, the solution should be permanent. Whatever we decide, we should stick to it. Second, the residents at the Veterans' Home should be considered. The proximity of the Veterans' Home to the hospital was intentional. There are approximately 15 residents at the Home who are Catholic. Some of them walked across the street and attended Mass weekly. The availability of Mass for them was part of the reason for the time and place of the Mass at Ascension/St. Vincent's. That will continue to be considered in whatever solution is decided upon.

Like the faith, things are always changing, but never ending. The Catholic presence in healthcare at Ascension/St. Vincent's is coming to an end. God still has plans for His Church and for its members. Let us try to be led by the Holy Spirit into the future.




