Father Bill's Weekly Message

DAY OF PRAYER AND PENANCE

January 22nd (Wednesday) is a Day of Prayer for Legal Protection of Unborn Children and Penance for Sins Against the Dignity of Human Life for all Catholics in the United States. It is a time to repent and pray for a culture of life in our country.

My advice is for Catholics to treat this day as they would treat Lent. Whatever prayers you add during Lent, pray those prayers on this day. Whatever you give up for Lent, give that up for this one day. Whatever special penance you do for Lent, do it on this day.

Prayer is important because we want God to show us how to be people of life. Penance is important because we need to change our minds and hearts to become people of life. Though abortion has become illegal in some states, we are far from having a culture of life in our country. We still tend to exploit the weak instead of protecting them.

Ann's New Life Center in Cropwell is a good example of what a culture of life would look like. They help parents before **and** after pregnancy. They are "life-friendly"; they support all life, not just certain groups. Though they call themselves a crisis pregnancy center, they are really a Pro-Life center.

Our parish will have an opportunity to support Ann's New Life Center in the next month. We will be sponsoring a "Baby Bottle Drive" where you can give your spare change to the center. Also, we will have a Shower of Blessings to provide items for Ann's New Life Center to give to the families who seek help from them.

Donating time, talent, or treasure to Ann's New Life Center would be good way to observe the Day of Prayer and Penance for children.

Columbarium Niches




